

Prof. dr. Ronny Bruffaerts, Center for Public Health Psychiatry; Universitair Psychiatrisch Centrum, KU Leuven (Leuven, Belgium), Institute for Social Research, University of Michigan (Ann Arbor, MI, USA)

Ronny Bruffaerts graduated in theoretical psychology (1997), clinical psychology (1998), and psychoanalytic psychotherapy (2004) at the KU Leuven, from which he received his PhD in Medical Sciences (2005). He chairs the Centre for Public Health Psychiatry within KULeuven. He had academic appointments at Johns Hopkins University (Baltimore, US) in 2012-2013 and University of Michigan (Ann Arbor, MI, US) from 2017 onwards. He is named the Fortune Chair in Promotion of Wellbeing (2014-2017) and the MindMates Chair in Suicide Prevention (2019-2024) at the KULeuven. His main research field is psychiatric epidemiology, where he uses a public health perspective in evaluating and guiding reforms in mental health care. He is appointed member of the Belgian Superior Health Counsel and has served as an expert in, among others, the (re)organization of psychiatric emergency services, the development of psychiatric networks, and the development of primary care psychology service provision.
