



Training and technical assistance to promote evidence-based practices

This workshop will provide detailed case studies in how the Center for Practice Innovations, an intermediary organization devoted to supporting the delivery of evidence based practices across New York State, structures its activities within an implementation science framework. Considerations will include so called “inner” and “outer” setting targets, and pre-implementation, implementation, and post-implementation activities. Methods include in-person and online synchronous and asynchronous activities. The workshop will discuss strengths and weaknesses of different methods and how to build an approach given system limitations.
